School Entrance/Arrival & Dismissal: The main entrance is now the door on the south end of the building, next to the new lunchroom (the door previously only used for dismissal). Parents must stop by Maria's office on the 2nd floor to sign in/out when visiting, dropping off students late or picking up students early. Parents are encouraged to notify the office or their teachers if picking up early, and we request that early pick-ups occur before 2pm; if picking up after 2pm, please wait until regular dismissal at 2:30pm. We apologize for any inconvenience during construction.

Phone System: The school phone system has been upgraded to make it easier to contact us during school hours. There is generally someone assigned to answer the phones at all times, but on the occasions that the administrative assistant is away from her desk and can't answer the phone, please follow the menu to leave a message for the party you are trying to reach or dial "O" for the operator.
