The Sabor de HoLa team has come up with a great idea to raise a significant amount of money at the 2012 Sabor de HoLa. The “Loco 50 Cincuenta” raffle!!! Why is it loco? Children's Healthy Cooking Classes Are Now Available in Hoboken!

Our own SmartCookies (provider of the HoLa Harvest "garden to table" Friday special this past fall) is launching an exciting program for kids to learn about cooking and healthy eating.

These "Kids in the Kitchen" programs are designed for children in grades 1-4 to encourage a natural curiosity about cooking and/or coax a shy eater out of their shell. Each week kids will follow simple recipes, practice basic cooking techniques, learn about nutrition and eating well, and participate in tons of fun hands on activities to get them excited about food and cooking. The programs run for 8 weeks, 90 minutes each week. They are offered in Level 1 and Level 2 and are designed to be taken consecutively.
