Head Lice: Spring break is a good time to get of lice once and for all! There were six cases of lice at HoLa last week, so it's important to keep checking your child's head on a regular basis. If you do discover lice, it may be treated with over the counter shampoos (your neighborhood pharmacist or your family doctor can assist you in selecting the best treatment for your child and for your family). Follow the directions closely on the package, which usually recommend doing a follow-up treatment with the shampoo a week later. Combing out your child's hair for nits and live bugs even after the treatment is also critical in making sure it's eradicated. Conditioner and olive oil are effective for this task. It's also important to remember that if your child is treated for lice, everyone in the family will need to have a treatment as well. All of the bed linens and clothing that have been used or worn by the family should also be washed in extremely hot water. You can also contact [Hair Fairies](#) who will help you treat and prevent lice.
