Lice Prevention and Treatment: As a preventive measure to avoid the spread of lice among our students, HoLa's school nurse Marylou Berhang, offers the following information: Check your child's head frequently for lice and/or nits (eggs). Mature lice, which are no larger than a sesame seed, avoid light and are hard to see. Lice eggs, called nits, are usually found very close to the scalp, typically within ¼ of an inch. They look like tiny whitish ovals that are glued to the hair shaft. Unlike dandruff, they cannot easily be flicked away. To check for nits, part the hair one section at a time and look for oval, tan-colored eggs. This can take many hours if there are a lot of nits present. To break the lice cycle you have to keep clearing both the nits as well as the lice out of the hair for 7-10 days, otherwise re-infestation will occur. Clothing, linen, and items such as stuffed animals should be thoroughly washed and dried. There are many products on the market that claim to repel lice, including "Fairytales" hair-care products. Makeover's Hoboken (302 Washington St), has given HoLa a coupon of 15% off all "Fairytales" products. See flyer for coupon. Please tell your children not to share hats, helmets, scarves, brushes, combs, or pillows, and please report any case of lice to Mrs. Berhang, (201) 427-1458 Ext. 203 or mberhang@holahoboken.org.



Dear HoLa Parents:

Hello, my name is David Celiberti. I am the father of Simon in 1-A and a psychologist who specializes in meeting the needs of underserved children with autism. I created Dine InDeed last year as a way to raise monies for the All Saints Day School Scholarship Fund, the Jubilee Center, and the Association for Science in Autism Treatment (I serve as Executive Director of this organization). The common thread underlying all three organizations is a commitment to creating meaningful opportunities for children to realize their potential! The following restaurants participated last year: Stacks, Anthony David's, Maxwell's, and Madison Bar & Grill and we **raised almost \$5000!**

This year, Dine InDeed will raise funds for the Boys and Girls Club, the Jubilee Center, and the Association for Science in Autism Treatment .
