Liberty Science Center (LSC): HoLa students, plus three family members or their friends can now visit Liberty Science Center for **FREE**. Intended to foster and encourage parent/child involvement in the areas of Science, Technology, Engineering and Mathematics (STEM), HoLa students need to bring a report card and mention they have a **Family Flex Pass Membership**. They get unlimited visits to LSC, and discounts to IMAX and 3D films. Valid through December 2013, except July and August. Dismissal Protocol: With the recent cold weather, questions have come up regarding our indoor/outdoor dismissal policy. Because Boys & Girls Club (our landlord) needs the gym immediately after school each day to accommodate their afterschool program, we are required to dismiss from the outside courtyard on most days (most other schools in Hoboken also dismiss from outside daily). They have made an exception for inclement weather – and now we have asked them to also make an exception for extremely cold weather, which they are willing to accommodate. Going forward, we will dismiss from the gym whenever it is raining, snowing or extremely cold (below 15 degrees is our general guideline). Please make an effort to exit the gym quickly on those days so that we don't delay the Boys & Girls programming. Thank you!
