NJASK: The NJASK Boot Camp for 3rd and 4th grade students, will begin Mon., Feb. 11th. Boot camp will be held on Mondays, Tuesdays, and Wednesdays from 3-3:50pm. This is an optional study session to help students focus on the skills necessary for the NJASK test. Boot camp will be held in the 3rd grade classrooms (aftercare will move to the 4th grade classrooms), and it will run for 10-12 weeks. On Mondays, the focus will be on reading comprehension and open-ended questions; Tuesdays, the components of speculative and expository writing; and Wednesdays, math concepts. All of the bed linens and clothing that have been worn by the student should also be washed in extremely hot water.
