Community Service Rocks! Along with the HoLa faculty, the PTO is sponsoring two weeks of community service activities. Beginning Tues., June 4th through Fri., June 14th we will be collecting shoes and non-perishable food items to give to two deserving charities. About *Soles4Souls*: *By recycling your gently worn shoes with the Soles4Souls, the discarded footwear will be given a second chance at life. By being redistributed through the organization's international micro-enterprise partners, men and women will be given the opportunity to break the cycle of poverty by earning a sustainable income.* This is a wonderful way to help your children make a meaningful donation. There is a 50% discount applied to the 5th and 6th week tuition when you register for 5 or more weeks. There is also a sibling discount of 10%. Cancellation policy: Full refund (less \$25 registration fee) prior to June 1. 50% refund from June 2 through June 28, 2013. No refunds after that. Full payment is due June 1, 2013.***
